The 20 countries represented in the G20 account for approximately 85% of the world's GDP and two-thirds of its population. These countries are-Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, European Union, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Russia, Mexico, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, UK and the USA. The G20 is important for India because it provides a platform for the country to engage with the world's largest economies, promote its economic interests, and address critical global issues.

About Chandrayaan-3:

Chandrayaan-3, the mission that aims to achieve the feat of conducting a "soft" landing on the Moon's southern pole, launched off from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Andhra Pradesh on Friday (July 14) afternoon. It will now take approximately 42 days to reach the Moon. It should conduct a successful landing. India will become the fourth country- after the United States, Russia and China - to have done so. Chandrayaan-3 consists of a Lander module (LM), Propulsion module (PM) and a Rover with an objective of developing and demonstrating new technologies required for Inter planetary missions. Building upon the success of its predecessors. Chandrayaan-I and Chandrayaan - 2, the third lunar mission is set to push the boundaries of space discovery and innovation. According to ISRO, the Chandrayaan 3 mission has three major objectives: demonstrate safe and soft landing on the surface of the Moon, conduct rover operations on the Moon and Conduct on-site experiments on the Lunar surface.

Painting Competition:

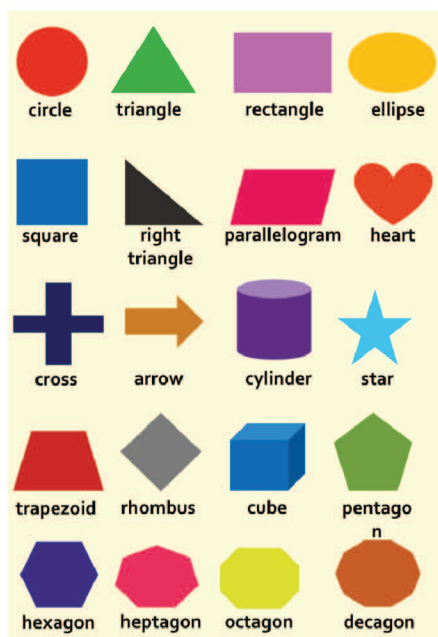
